## CURBSIDE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Newspapers will be collected at curbside.

**Materials should be placed at the curb in the following manner:**

2. The following mixed recyclables will be collected curbside:

#### **NEWSPAPERS:**

\*Glass and bottles (all colors).

\*Aluminum cans.

\*Tin plates, steel cans (soup, juice, etc.).

Plastic soda bottles (clear and green) milk/water/cider containers, shampoo, conditioner, liquid laundry soap, fabric softener, and bleach containers.

\*No plastic tubs will be accepted.

Should be dry and tied in bundles. Packaging in plastic bags is not acceptable. Colored inserts may be included with recyclable newspaper but magazines or other grades of paper that are not part of the newspaper are not acceptable. ***Wet newspapers will not be collected. On rainy days, newspapers will not be picked up.***

#### **MIXED RECYCLABLES:**

3. Magazines, junk mail, and cardboard ***will not*** be collected curbside but can be brought to the Recycling Center during normal hours of operation.

All bottles, cans, and plastics must be rinsed clean with caps and lids removed and placed mixed at the curb in no larger than a **35-gallon waterproof container.** Cardboard boxes and grocery sacks are not acceptable. Do not include windows, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramics, dishes, broken glass, or any other material with your mixed recyclables. These recyclables or those materials not placed properly at the curb **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED** and warning notices may be issued. Anything placed in a larger container will not be picked up curbside.

REMEMBER: MATERIALS MUST BE AT THE CURB NO LATER THAN 7:00AM ON YOUR DESIGNATED PICK-UP DAY. PLEASE REFER TO THE SCHEDULE ON PAGE 2.

**There will be NO exceptions.**

**IMPORTANT BRUSH INFORMATION:**

- Tree limbs must be smaller than 4 inches in diameter. The cleanup is intended for residents to clear away naturally occurring fallen winter brush and light pruning. Property owners are responsible for felled trees.
- Non-chippable items including leaves, vines, stumps, and building material will not be collected during the Spring. All yard waste must be taken to Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority—SCMUA—in Lafayette for disposal. For more information call 973-579-6998 or visit [www.scmua.org](http://www.scmua.org).



## BULK WASTE COLLECTION

Bulk Waste Curbside Collection will occur on May 2, 2020 and will coincide with the 2020 Neighbors Helping Neighbors event. Residents will be allowed to place up to 500 lbs. of bulky items for the collection curbside. NO electronics, household garbage, recyclable material, clothing, building materials, brush/leaves/grass, hazardous materials or tires will be collected.

Permits for the 2020 Bulk Waste Collection will be available for purchase starting on April 6th at the Municipal Building, 39 Trinity Street on the 2nd floor. The permit cost is \$35. Additional details will be provided with the permit.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### Items must be in containers.

Failure to comply with this regulation will result in those items placed in plastic bags **not** being picked up curbside. If items placed in plastic bags are brought to the Recycling Center, they **will not** be accepted.

Be advised any cardboard, magazines or junk mail placed in paper bags or plastic bags **will not** be accepted.

Plastic Bags left curbside or brought to the Recycling Center containing mixed recyclable items will not be accepted.

**Brush, leaves, and grass clippings** are **not** accepted at the Recycling Center.

Leaves and grass clippings can be brought to the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority located at 34 South, Route 94, Lafayette, NJ.

**Electronic Equipment** is **not** accepted at the Recycling Center. Contact SCMUA at 973-579-6998 for information on how to dispose of it.

A Town Recycling Pass or Driver's License showing a Newton street address must be presented for inspection upon entrance.

For your information, residents and businesses can now recycle the following:

**Chipboard:** Food, tissue & other gray or white paperboard can be included with cardboard. No wax coated material (i.e. Juice Boxes).

**Plastic Containers:** All rinsed plastic containers with codes between 1 (PET) and 7(OTHER) can be included with commingled containers.

\*No plastic toys.
