3. Applicant **MUST** be available on August 3rd and August 5th to represent the Town of Newton at the Queen of the Fair contest. If selected as Queen of the Fair, winner must be available at the Fairgrounds throughout the week.
4. A written essay, not to exceed two (2) typed pages double-spaced, explaining why you would be a good representative of Newton. The essay must be submitted with this entry form.
5. A bio no more than 250 words to be submitted with this entry form. The biography should include any hobbies, talents, special interests, or accomplishments as well as any significant family or school history. The biography will be used as an introduction at the event.
6. Several questions to be answered by each applicant on the day of the competition in front of the judges.
7. You will be judged on personal presentation, poise, demeanor, and overall appearance.
