

Town of Newton Utility Advisory Board  
July 25, 2017

A special meeting of the Newton Utility Advisory Board was held on July 25, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. at the Newton Municipal Building, 39 Trinity Street, Newton. Chairman Lawler called the meeting to order and the following members were present: Mr. Vrahnos, and Mr. Lockwood. Mr. David Simmons, Engineer, Mr. Richard Lulla, Engineer, Ms. Tiffany Heineman, Attorney, Mr. Blake Ellman, Owner Krogh's Brewing, LLC, Mr. Jason Dunn, Dykstra Associates, and Mrs. Jacki Shackleton, Utility Collector, were also in attendance.

Chairman Lawler began the discussion with a question regarding Domestic Waste which was listed at an estimated 640 GPD in the Wastewater Discharge Volume Information. The Schematic Flow Diagram referenced the same 640 GPD in Sanitary Sewer, with an additional 32 GPD in Utilities. Chairman Lawler was questioning the discrepancy. Mr. Ellman stated that the amount was minimal and assured Chairman Lawler that if the Board would approve the total GPD of 672, they would forward a hard copy with the correct GPD once they discussed the discrepancy. Chairman Lawler stated that that was acceptable and motioned to approve the application. Mr. Lockwood seconded the motion and it was approved with an "aye" vote.

There being no other business to discuss, Chairman Lawler adjourned the meeting.
