The Newton Advisory Board of Health held a regular meeting on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Dr. Nancy Craddock, Dr. John Craddock, Mr. Hagaman and Mrs. Lorraine Read, Secretary were in attendance. Christine Whitehead, Health Inspector from the Sussex County Board of Health was also present. Dr. Ford and Rev. Carlson were absent.

Dr. Nancy Craddock made the following declaration that "in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regular meeting was given to the two newspapers of record and posted on the official bulletin board on December 31, 2014."

Upon motion of Mr. Hagaman, seconded by Dr. John Craddock and carried, the minutes of March 25, 2015 Regular meeting were unanimously approved.

Under Old Business, Mrs. Read provided a brief update on the licensing of Newton Auto Salvage. This facility is still unlicensed due to the pending issues with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP). Mrs. Whitehead is awaiting approval from the State prior to her approval from the County of Sussex.

Mrs. Whitehead indicated there was no update on the pending issues surrounding the New Jersey Smoke-Free Air Act and will keep Board updated.

Under New Business, Mrs. Read and Mrs. Whitehead reviewed the routine health notices submitted by the Sussex County Health Department and addressed all questions.
