After a brief discussion, Council asked the Clerk to obtain clarification on potential conflict with Mrs. Bucci serving on the Planning Board due to her present employment as a Realtor.

The Town Council thanked Mrs. Bucci for volunteering her time to the community and will advise her of their findings.

There being no further business to be discussed, upon motion of Mr. Flynn, seconded by Mrs. Diglio and carried, the Council adjourned at 7:02 p.m.
