The regular meeting of the Newton Recreation Commission was called to order at 7:30 PM on October 16, 2019 by Chairwoman Karen Crossley.

**Roll Call:** Mrs. Bucci, Mr. Coward via teleconference, Mrs. Zito, Chairwoman Crossley. Mrs. Rossi was excused.
