The Newton Advisory Board of Health held a regular meeting on the above date at 7:07 p.m. Present were Dr. Nancy Craddock, Dr. John Craddock, Mr. William Hagaman and Mrs. Teresa A. Oswin, BOH Secretary. Dr. Beatrix Bueno was absent. Maria Cuevas-Greco, Health Inspector from the Sussex County Board of Health was also present.

Dr. Nancy Craddock made the following declaration that "in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regular meeting was given to the two newspapers of record and posted on the official bulletin board on January 4, 2021."

Upon motion of Dr. J. Craddock, seconded by Mr. Hagaman and carried, the minutes of June 23, 2021 Regular meeting were unanimously approved.

There was no Unfinished Business to discuss.

Under New Business, Ms. Cuevas-Greco reviewed the routine health notices submitted by the Sussex County Health Department. Dr. Nancy Craddock asked several questions on different violations and all questions were addressed.

Mrs. Oswin reviewed the recent ordinances adopted by the Newton Town Council. Explaining Ordinance 2021-8 created setback exemptions for wheelchair ramps in all zones, and Ordinance 2021-11 amends smoking prohibitions in Town to include cannabis.

A brief discussion took place on the new cannabis ordinances the Town Council adopted.
