The Newton Advisory Board of Health held a regular meeting on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Dr. Nancy Craddock, Dr. John Craddock, Mr. Ford, Mr. Carlson and Mrs. Lorraine Read, Secretary were in attendance. Christine Davey, Health Inspector from the Sussex County Board of Health was also present. Mr. Hagaman was excused.

Dr. Nancy Craddock made the following declaration that "in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regular meeting was given to the two newspapers of record and posted on the official bulletin board on December 31, 2013."

Upon motion of Mr. Carlson, seconded by Dr. Ford and carried, the minutes of September 25, 2013 Regular meeting was approved.

There being Old Business, under New Business, Mrs. Read updated the Board on the issuance of the two junk dealer licenses in Town. It was noted that both were in compliance and licenses have been issued through 2014.

Mrs. Read reviewed the Disruptive Property Ordinance which was adopted by the Town Council in May, 2013. This Ordinance shall establish a new Article III to Chapter 213 of the Code of the Town of Newton, requiring certain landlords to post adequate security against the consequences of disorderly behavior of the tenants. After a brief discussion, the Board members expressed their support of the Town Ordinance.

Mrs. Read and Mrs. Davey reviewed the routine health notices submitted by the Sussex County Health Department. Mrs. Davey updated the Board members on various health issues and addressed all questions.

Dr. Nancy Craddock opened the meeting to the public.

There being no one from the public to be heard, upon motion of Dr. Ford, seconded by Dr. John Craddock and carried, the meeting adjourned at 8:28 p.m.
