Addendum No. 4**

WHEREAS, as the Newton Emergency Management Coordinator, I, Kenneth Teets, previously declared a Local State of Emergency by way of Proclamation of Local Emergency 2020-1; and

WHEREAS, Addendum No. 1 was issued to add additional information regarding said Proclamation of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, Addendum No. 2 was issued to address access to various municipal facilities and the scheduling of certain meetings; and

WHEREAS, Addendum No. 3 was issued to address parameters for utilization of Memory Park and Pine Street Park; and

WHEREAS, I have determined it is necessary, in consultation with Newton Town Manager Thomas S. Russo, Jr., to implement modifications in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of Town employees and volunteers, and members of the general public;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, that I, Kenneth Teets, Newton Emergency Management Coordinator, do hereby order the following, effective 8:30am, Thursday, July 2, 2020:

1. The rules promulgated by Addendums 1, 2, and 3 shall be lifted in their entirety; and
2. The Newton Municipal Building will re-open for public business with modified hours of 9:30am-3:30pm, Monday through Friday, starting Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup>; and
3. Customers entering the Newton Municipal Building to conduct public business shall be required to wear masks and abide by proper social distancing protocols; and
4. Playground equipment at Memory Park and Pine Street Park shall now be opened for public use with adherence to proper social distancing protocols.

These rules remain in place until lifted by order of the Town Manager or by the Newton Office of Emergency Management.
