Residential Curbside BULK Collection Pickup by Permit - Permit available for purchase March 9, 2026

- Permit is required for collection.
- Up to 500 pounds of bulky waste at curbside for collection.
- Permit cost is \$50. and non-refundable
- Call DPW at 973-383-4160 for more information or to register.
- Permits become available on Monday, March 2. To arrange a pickup appointment, call 973-383-4160.
- Permits requests can also be mailed to Town of Newton, 39 Trinity Street, Newton, NJ 07860 Attn: DPW or/ dropped off to the mailbox at 117 Moran Street, DPW Complex in Memory Park.
- Once the permit is issued, you will receive a list of do's and don'ts for the event.



Food Waste Bin

- Distribution of countertop containers for food-waste collection.
- The Recycle Center provides a designated receptacle for the disposal of food-waste contents (neon green bin).

Tires & Rims

- CLEAN - NO WATER OR DEBRIS.
- Passenger Cars.
- Bicycle.
- Motorcycle.
- Any size or style tire rim.

Collection crews typically begin their route at 5:00 AM and are usually finished and out of town by 12:00 PM.

With a proper pre-paid permit, you may place up to 500 lbs. of bulky waste curbside.

Restrictions are as follows:

- No Tires (Collection Event May 2 at the Newton Recycle Center from 8am to 1pm)
- No Car Parts (these can be recycled in the scrap metal bin at the recycle center year-round)
- No Construction Debris (this is considered trash)
- No Chemicals
- No Oils and Lubricants (Collection Event May 2 at the Newton Recycle Center from 8am to 1pm)
- No CFC/Freon appliances (must be removed for pickup)
- No Electronics (these can be recycled in the electronics bin at the recycle center year-round)
- No Household garbage & Recyclable materials
- No Clothing (these can be recycled in the clothing bin at the recycle center year-round)
- No Building Material
- No Brush/Leaves/Grass (with an appointment, these can be recycled at the recycle center year-round)
- No Hazardous Materials

Collected items may include household appliances with Freon removed - commonly referred to as white goods (these items can also be recycled year-round in the metal bin at the Newton Recycle Center), couches, tables chairs, mattresses, bedsprings.

If you have a particular item and are not sure, just call or email and I will confirm with Blue Diamond.
